



Call for Poster Presentations

We invite you to present a poster at the Albany or Batavia conference – or both.
Albany (July 27-28, 2010) - Application due by July 14th
Batavia (August 16-17, 2010) - Application due by August 6th

Purpose of Poster Session: To share promising practices occurring in communities throughout the state with conference attendees, including seniors, senior service providers and area agencies on aging, local and state officials, community developers and others.

Poster Content Requirements:

- Demonstrate a successful outcome resulting from a community empowerment planning process or implementation of an initiative that makes your community more elder friendly.
- Identify major steps taken throughout the process, the key stakeholders, how seniors were involved and the outcome for the community.
- Include contact information for those interested in more information.

Poster Guidelines:

- Two dimensional and able to be presented on a provided easel or 6' table top.
- No electricity or AV equipment will be provided.
- No for-profit enterprises can be promoted.

Participation:

- Applicants will be accepted on a first come first served basis.
- Applicants will receive an email confirming their participation in the poster show, to be brought to conference registration table.
- A presenter is encouraged to be on site at the poster show, and will be expected to register for the conference for the days they are in attendance. There is no additional cost to present a poster.
- The Conference Planning Committee reserves the right to deny (on site) the presentation of a poster that fails to meet the requirements and guidelines or is determined to be inappropriate.
